Happy Birthday, Pastor Alexander!

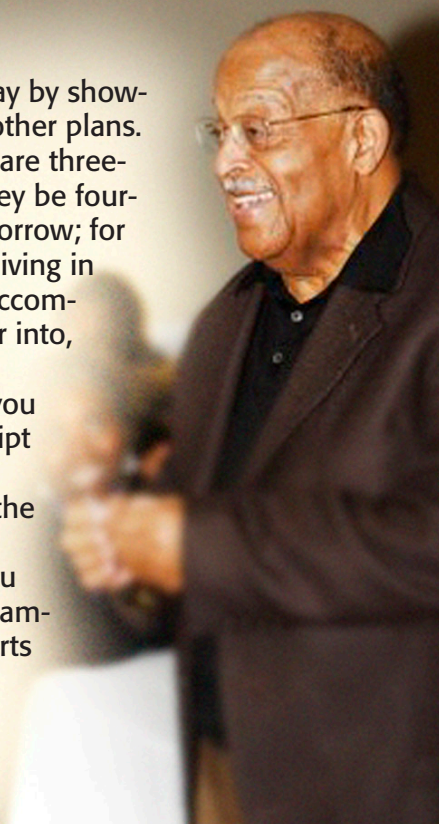
Dear Pastor Cameron M. Alexander,

Black History Facts You May Not Know...

One in four cowboys was Black, despite the stories told in popular books and movies.

In fact, it's believed that the real "Lone Ranger" was inspired by an African American man named Bass Reeves. Reeves had been born a slave but escaped West during the Civil War where he lived in what was then known as Indian Territory. He was a master of disguise, an expert marksman, had a Native American companion, and rode a silver horse. He was the first black U.S. Deputy Marshall west of the Mississippi River. He worked mostly in Arkansas and the Oklahoma Territory. During his long career, he was credited with arresting more than 3,000 felons.
