




M.A.N. PRAYER BREAKFAST

HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY: For the week ending February 184, 2012, 387 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$9,310 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 11,650 pounds of food was distributed, 698 meals served to AUMI residents, and 310 community meals served. **CLOTHING BANK**: Thirty-six (36) families received goods through the Clothing Bank.
