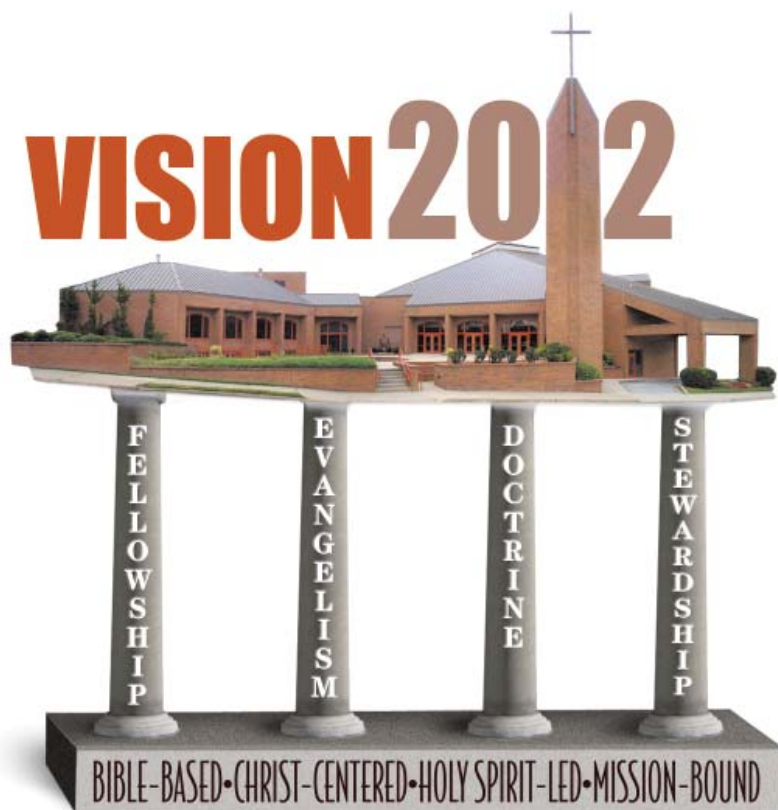

HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY: For the week ending March 3, 2012, 316 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$7,365 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 12,771 pounds of food was distributed, 651 meals served to AUMI residents, and 313 community meals served. Outreach Ministries received 3,770 pounds of food.
