### **HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY**

For the week ending May 21, 2011, 298 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$5,480 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 7,100 pounds of food was distributed, 695 meals served to AUMI residents, and 338 community meals served.
