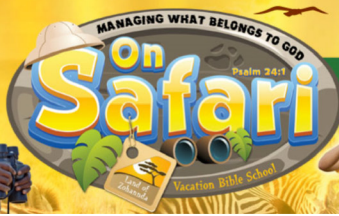
## **WEEKLY PRAYER MEETING & BIBLE STUDY**
