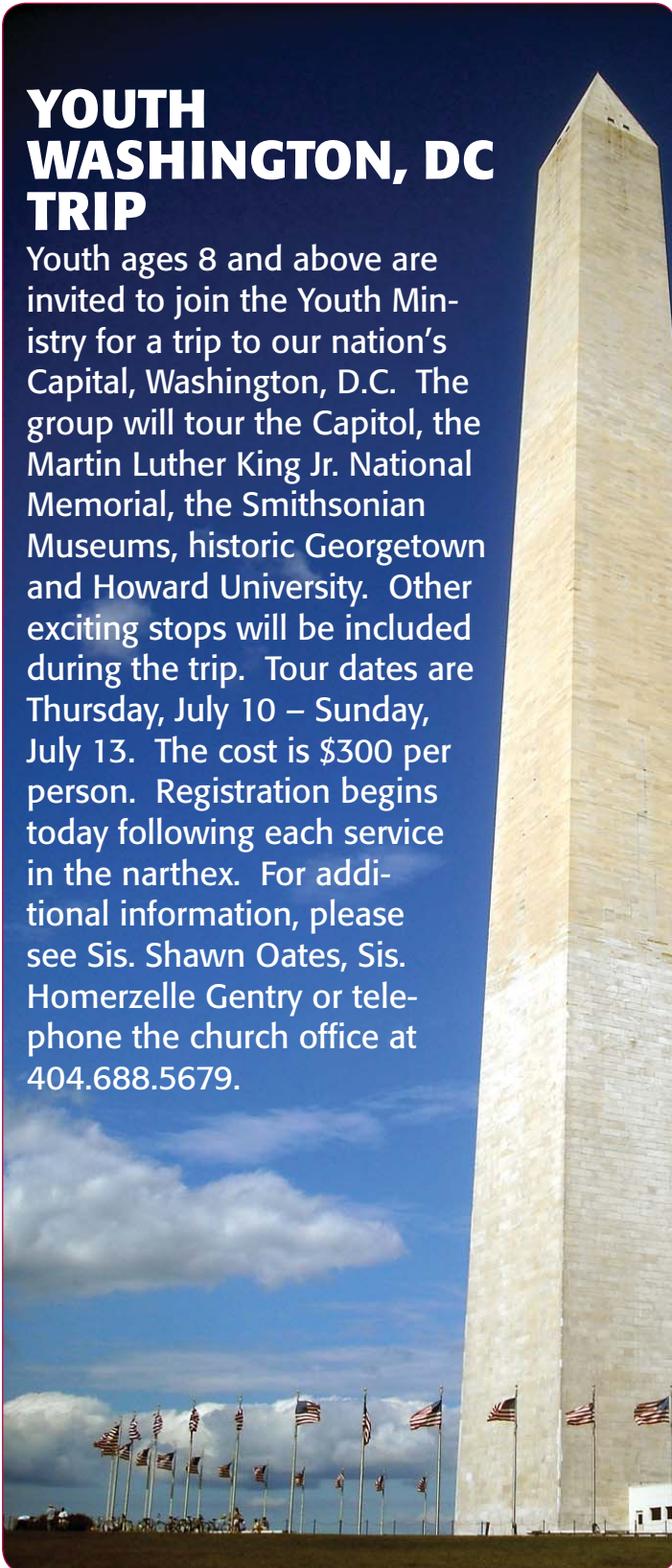
## YOUTH WASHINGTON, DC TRIP
