## IT'S BACK TO SCHOOL TIME!!

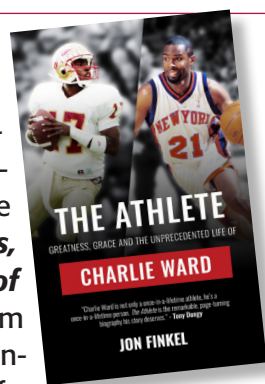
