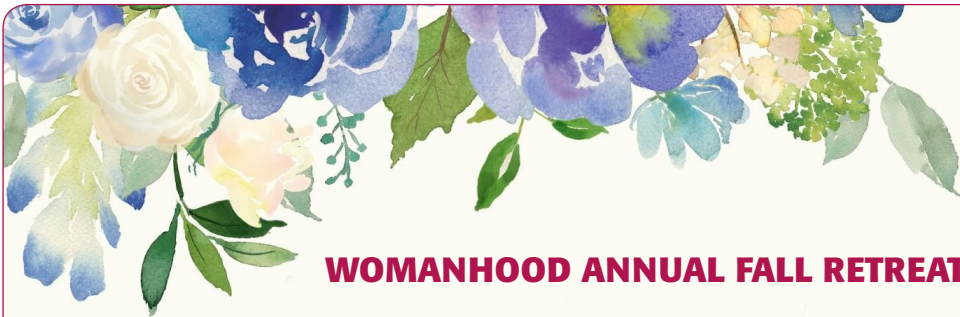
SUNDRESS AND SANDALS
