## TODAY IN SUNDAY SCHOOL

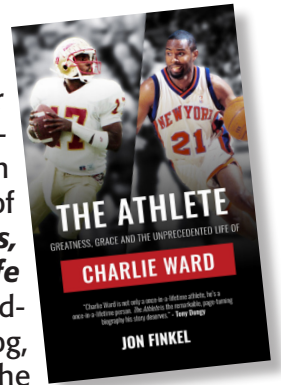

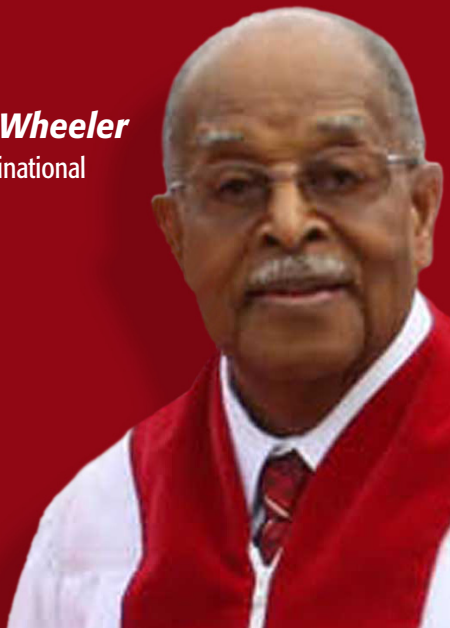
