TODAY IN SUNDAY SCHOOL

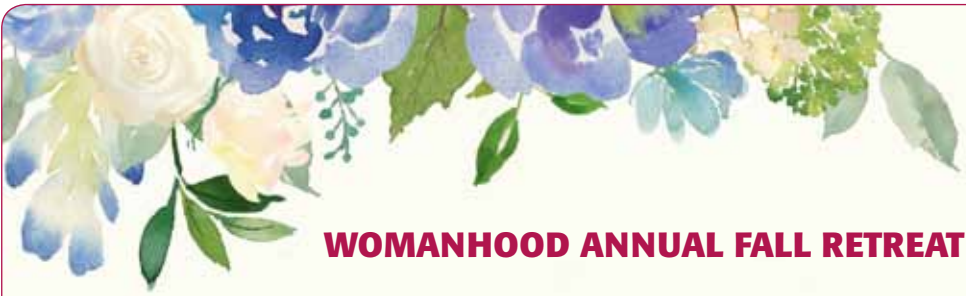
