

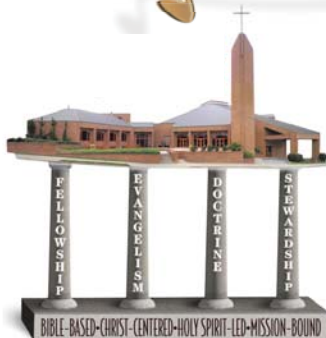

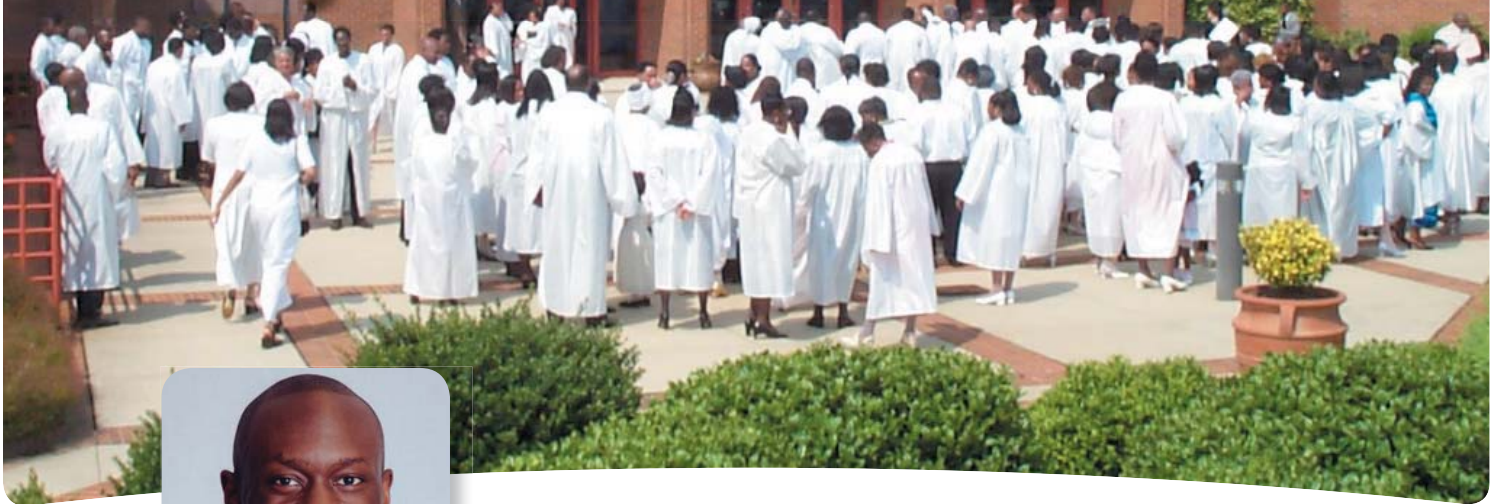
ORIENTATION CLASSES

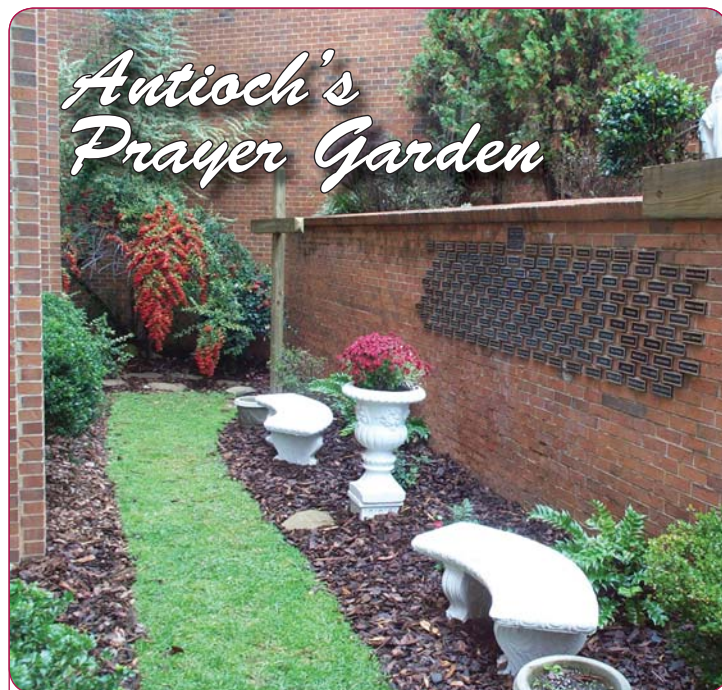
