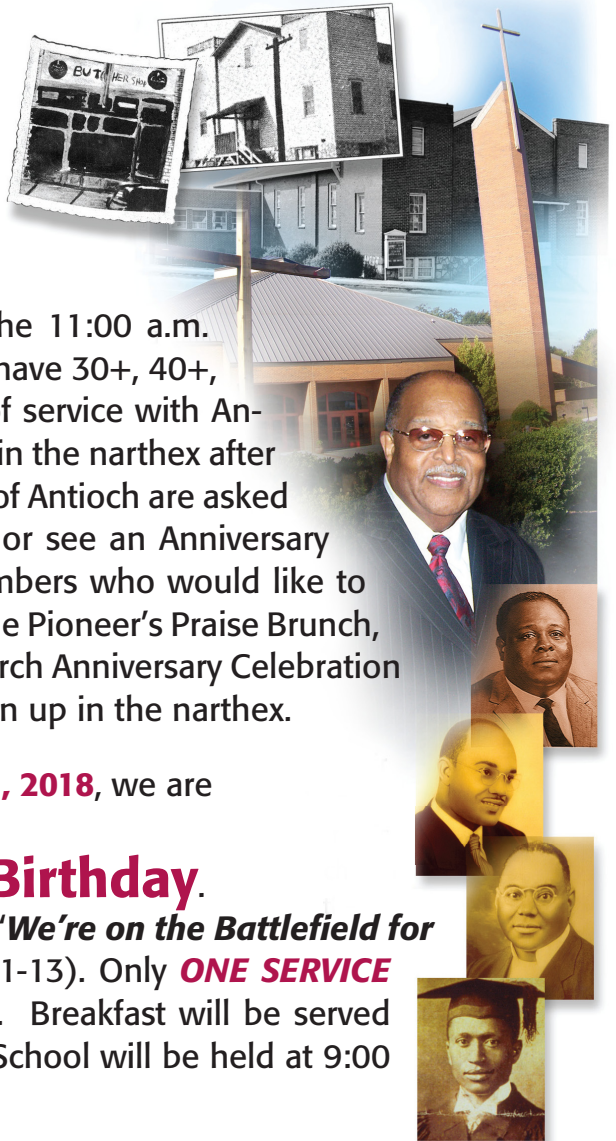
## Pioneers Recognition Sunday
