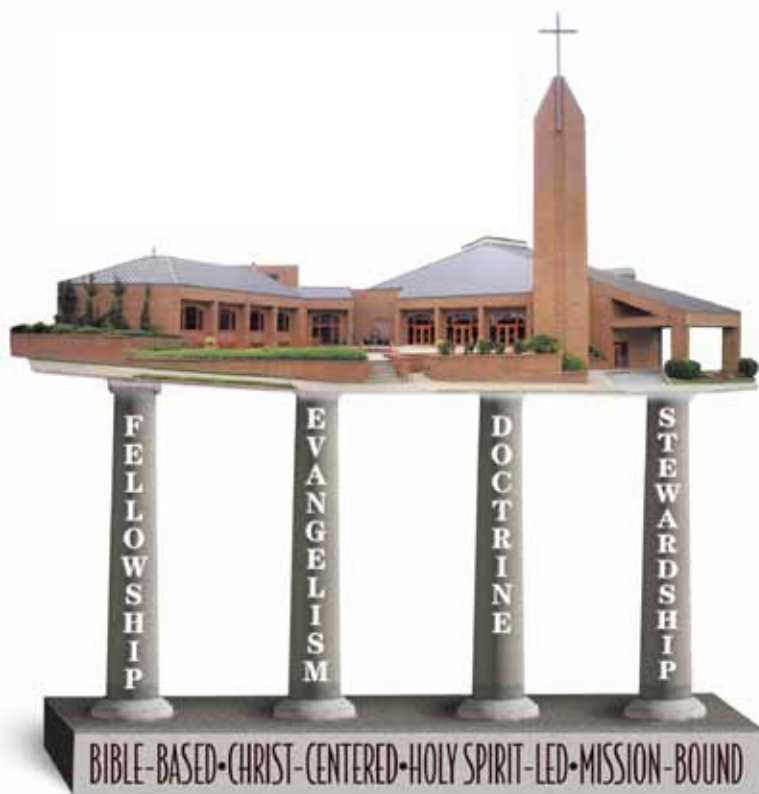

## THE RIGHT HAND OF FELLOWSHIP

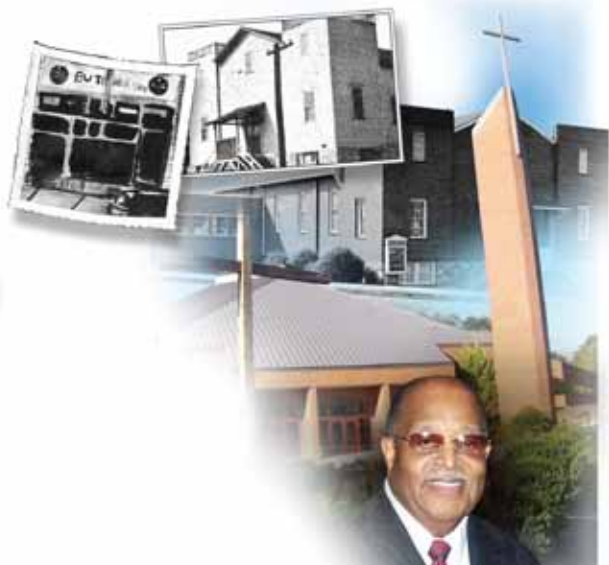
