The deadline for bringing toys is Friday, December 16.

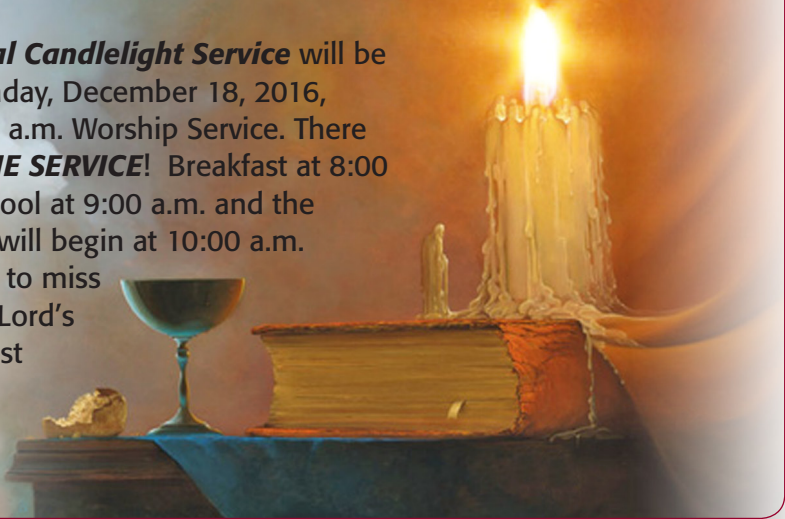


ATTENTION MEMBERS AND FRIENDS!
