HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY

For the week ending November 25, 2010, 119 food boxes were distributed along with 272 Thanksgiving boxes. The value of the groceries was \$13,455 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 7,732 pounds of food was distributed, 624 meals served to AUMI residents, and 280 community meals served.
