MINISTER: Then delivered he him therefore unto them to be crucified. And they took Jesus, and led him away.

CONGREGATION: And he bearing his cross went forth into a place called the place of a skull, which is called in the Hebrew Golgotha:

MINISTER: Where they crucified him, and two other with him, on either side one, and Jesus in the midst.

CONGREGATION: When Jesus therefore saw his mother, and the disciple standing by, whom he loved, he saith unto his mother, Woman, behold thy son!

MINISTER: Then saith he to the disciple, Behold thy mother! And from that hour that disciple took her unto his own home.

CONGREGATION: After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, I thirst.

MINISTER: Now there was set a vessel full of vinegar: and they filled a sponge with vinegar, and put it upon hyssop, and put it to his mouth.

CONGREGATION: When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he saith, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.


