



Antioch Urban Ministries, Inc. (AUMI) is a non-profit, 501 c3, charitable organization founded in 1990 as an advocacy agent which provides comprehensive substance abuse recovery services to persons who are homeless, low income, recently released from incarceration and/or are living with HIV/AIDS. In addition AUMI provides essential services to families throughout Metropolitan Atlanta and surrounding areas through our food and clothing bank, internet access, job search and other social support services.

MINISTRY AND SOCIAL SERVICES PROGRAMS

Food Bank distributes 23,400 boxes of food annually to persons in the community, seniors, and the GNAP program through a collaboration with the Atlanta Community Food Bank.

Clothing Bank, through in-kind donations, provides clothing, shoes and accessories to men, women and children

Matthew's Place, through collaboration with the City of Atlanta Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS (HOPWA), provides housing and social services.

Luke's Place provides housing and social services for men recovering from substance abuse/homelessness

Ruth's Place provides housing and social services for women recovering from substance abuse/homelessness.

Computers provide internet access, resume building, job search, and more, for residents and the community

Social Services Referral Base, in conjunction with United Way and Toy's 4 Tots, provides a resource for Christmas toys annually. Through in-kind donations from Antioch Baptist Church North, Christmas Trees are provided for more than 30 families each year.

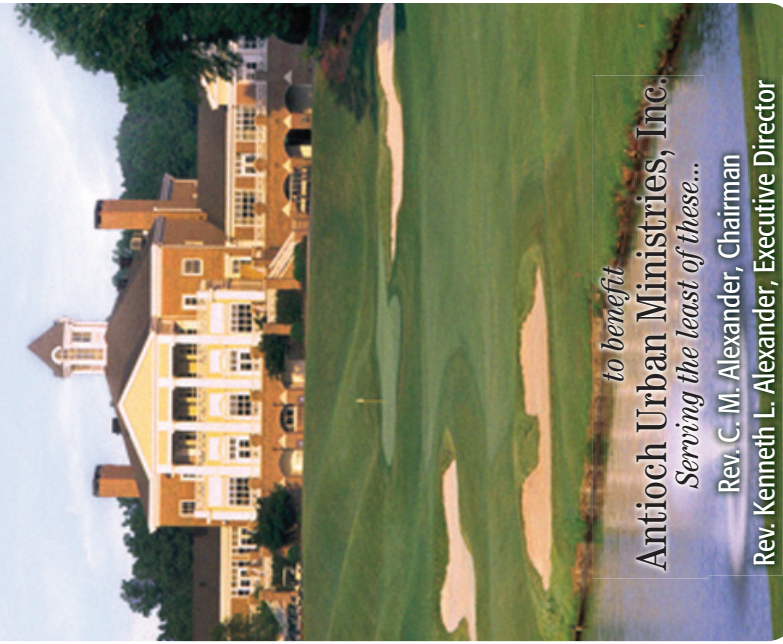
