Some of our honorees today have come to a milepost marker on the journey of life despite many of them facing challenges such as overcoming insurmountable obstacles with social separation due to the pandemic, having to pivot and do online learning, and reentry to in-person learning where some children had to play catch up.

Moving from kindergarten to first grade is a time to stay actively engaged in the learning process for the entire day. 
