# **HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY**

For the week ending December 25, 2010, 310 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$10,850 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 2,363 pounds of food was distributed, 654 meals served to AUMI residents, 185 community meals served, and 70 CSFP boxes were distributed to seniors.
