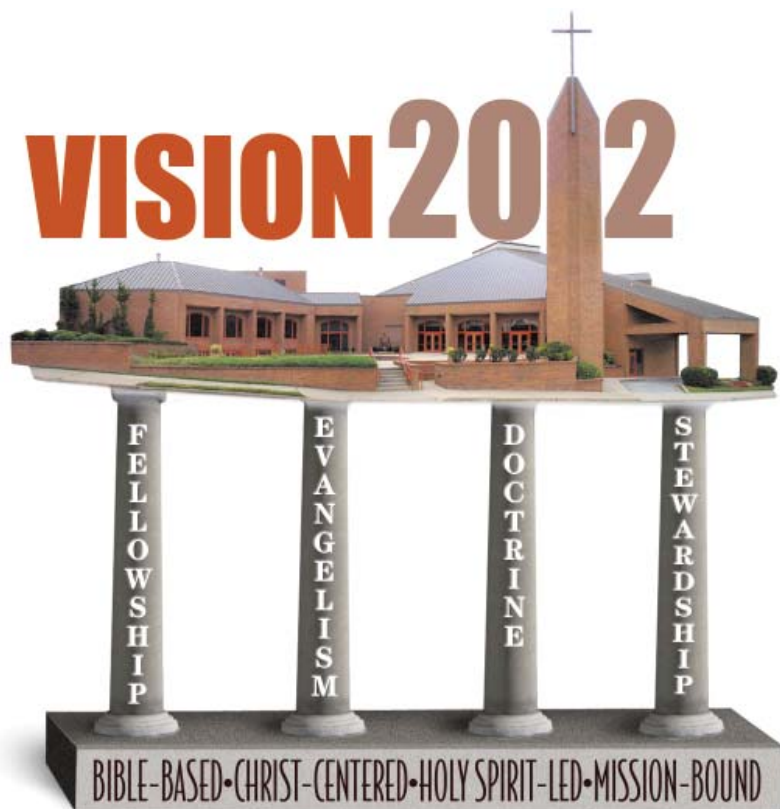

HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY: For the week ending January 21, 2012, 446 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$11,035 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 16,285 pounds of food was distributed, 657 meals served to AUMI residents, and 209 community meals served. We received and distributed 3,500 gallons of milk, and 95 boxes were distributed to seniors in the CSFP Program. **CLOTHING BANK:** Twenty-nine(29) families received goods through the Clothing Bank.
