

HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY

For the week ending January 22, 2011, 423 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$10,395 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 7,936 pounds of food was distributed, 631 meals served to AUMI residents, and 448 community meals served.

CLOTHING BANK

Thirty-five (35) families received goods through the Clothing Bank.
