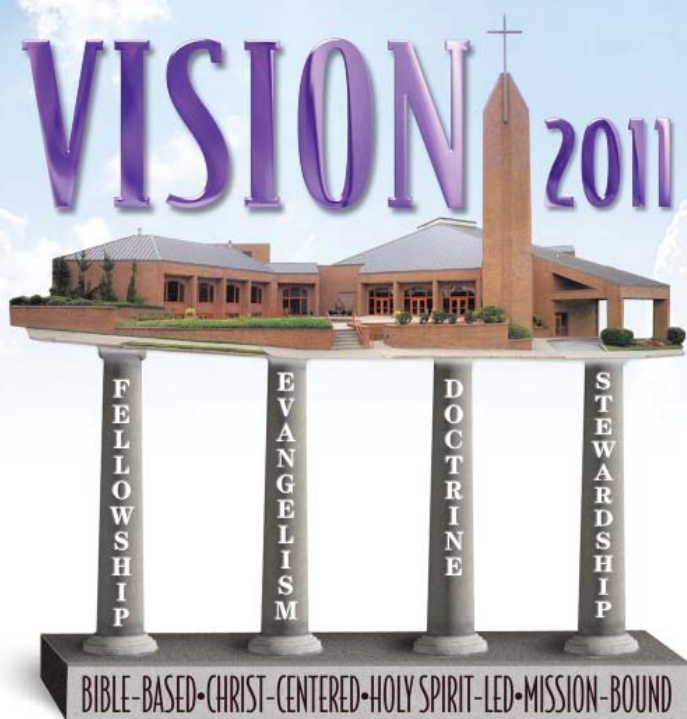

HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY

For the week ending January 29, 2011, 428 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$10,245 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 7,350 pounds of food was distributed, 670 meals served to AUMI residents, and 388 community meals served.
