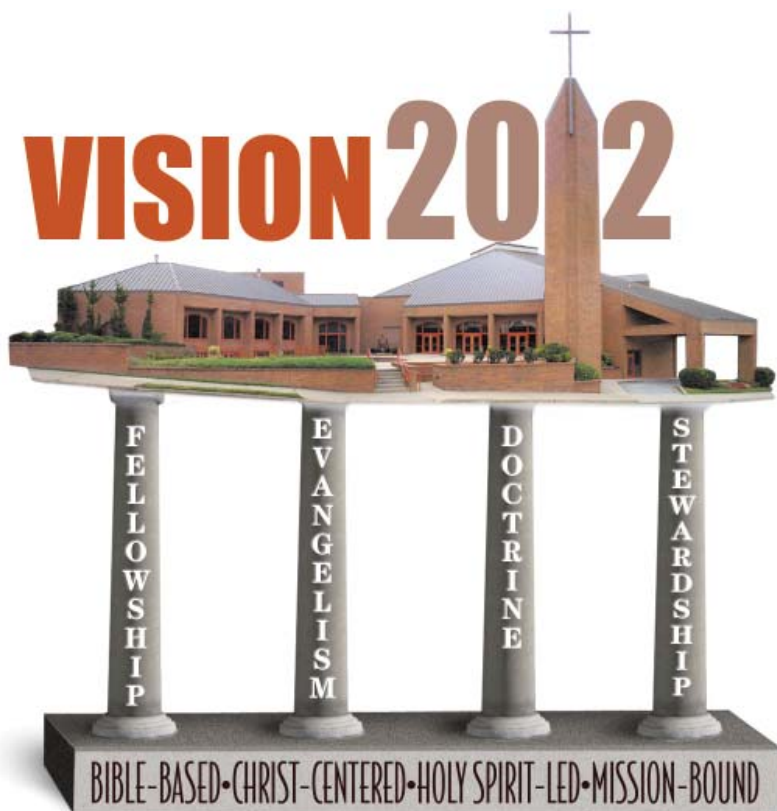

HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY: For the week ending February 4, 2012, 380 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$9,175 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 11,065 pounds of food was distributed, 696 meals served to AUMI residents, and 118 community meals served.

CLOTHING BANK: Twenty-three(23) families received goods through the Clothing Bank.
