

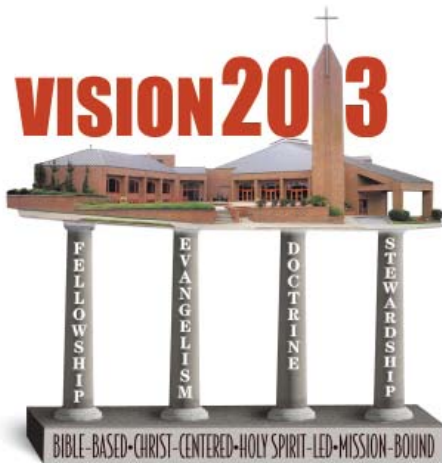

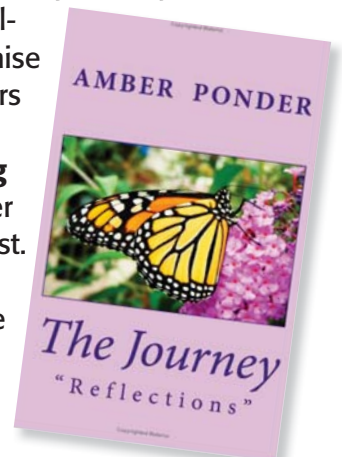
SCHOLARSHIP SUNDAY
