

HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY: For the week ending February 25, 2012, 404 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$9,690 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 14,077 pounds of food was distributed, 673 meals served to AUMI residents, and 186 community meals served. Outreach Ministries received 1,350 pounds of food.
