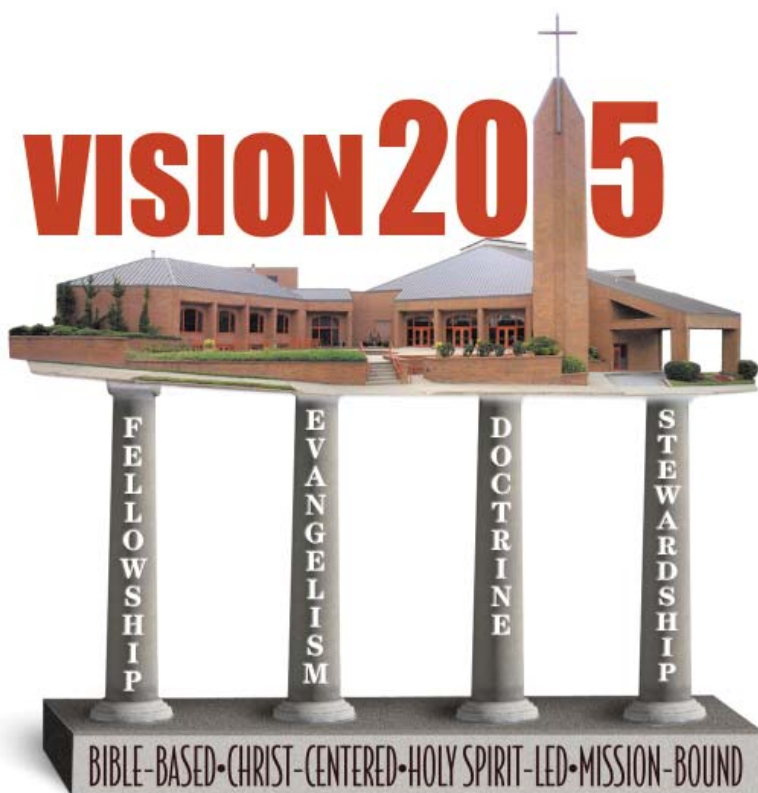

PALM SUNDAY

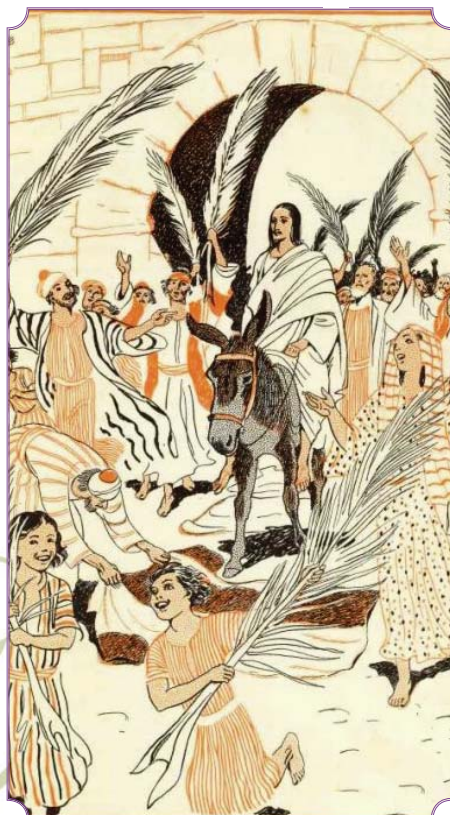
