For the week ending March 26, 2011, 400 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$9,280 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 7,460 pounds of food was distributed, 738 meals served to AUMI residents, and 629 community meals served.
