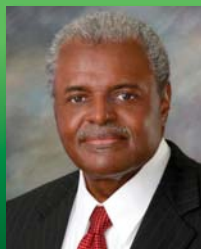

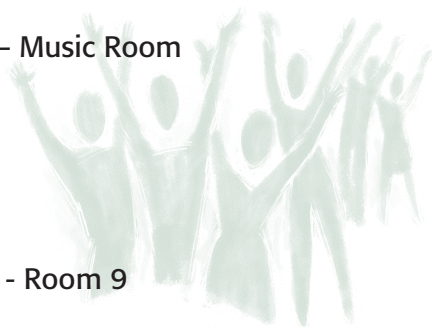

### **HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY**

For the week ending April 16, 2011, 298 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$7,165 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 8,750 pounds of food was distributed, 704 meals served to AUMI residents, and 343 community meals served.
