

Acts 2: 1-17 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. For the week ending June 4, 2011, 283 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$7,060 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 6,340 pounds of food was distributed, 690 meals served to AUMI residents, and 289 community meals served.
