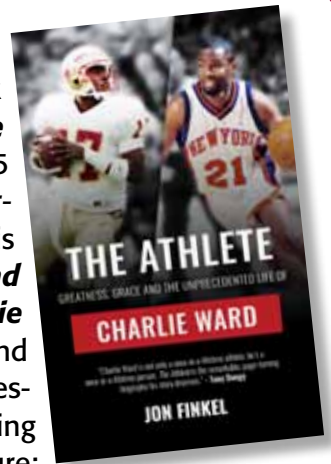
BOOK SIGNING
