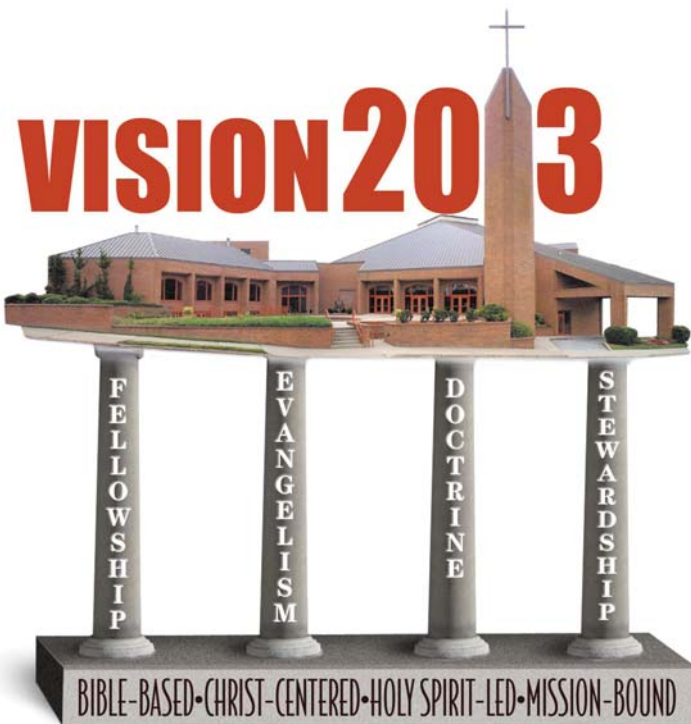

For the week ending June 29, 2013, 422 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$10,000 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 10,148 pounds of food was distributed, 542 meals served to AUMI residents, and 332 community meals served.
