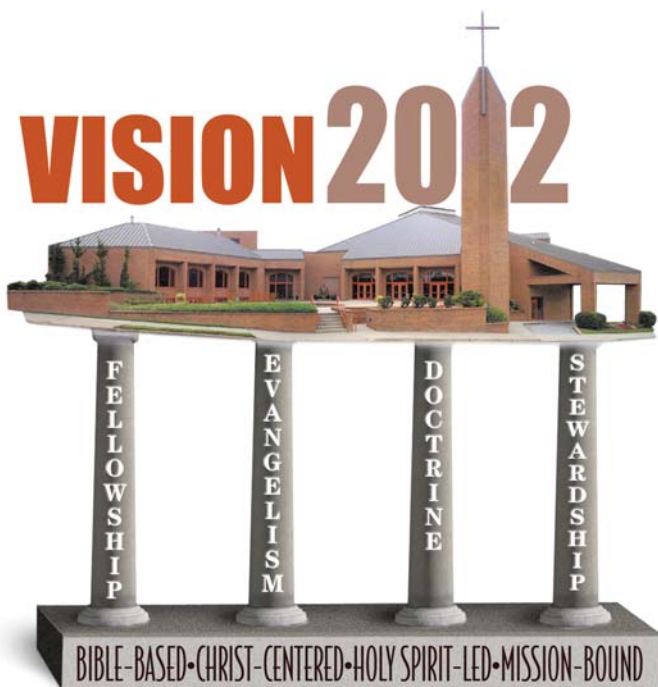

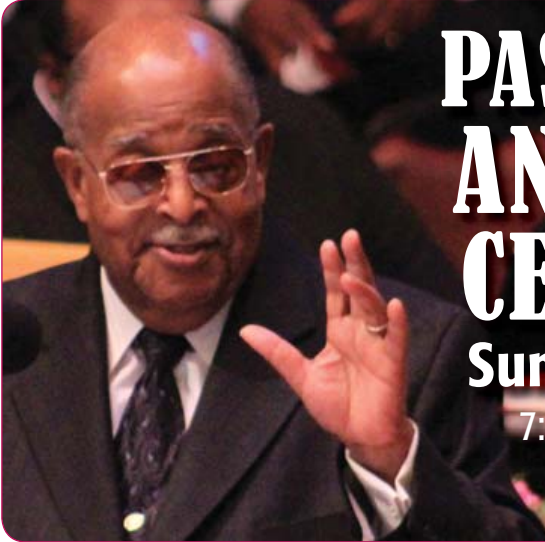

HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY

For the week ending June 30, 2012, 437 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$10,670 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 2,685 pounds of food was distributed, 663 meals served to AUMI residents, and 346 community meals served.
