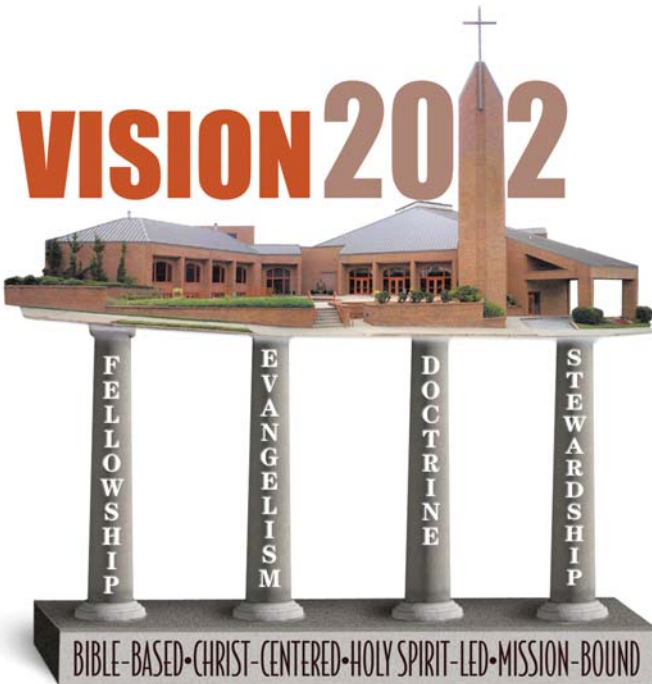

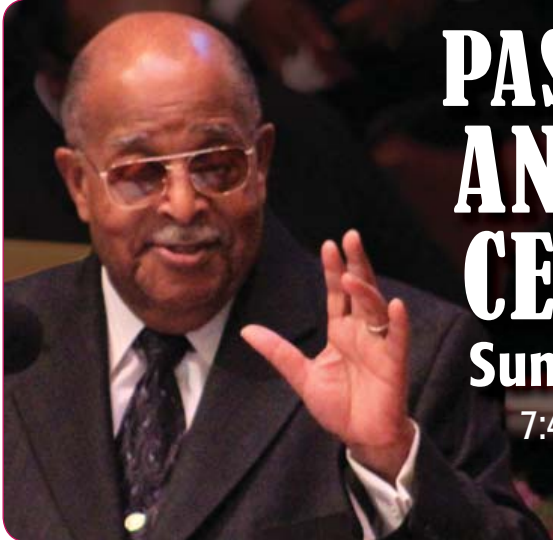
DANCING THROUGH THE DECADES - July 27, 7pm
