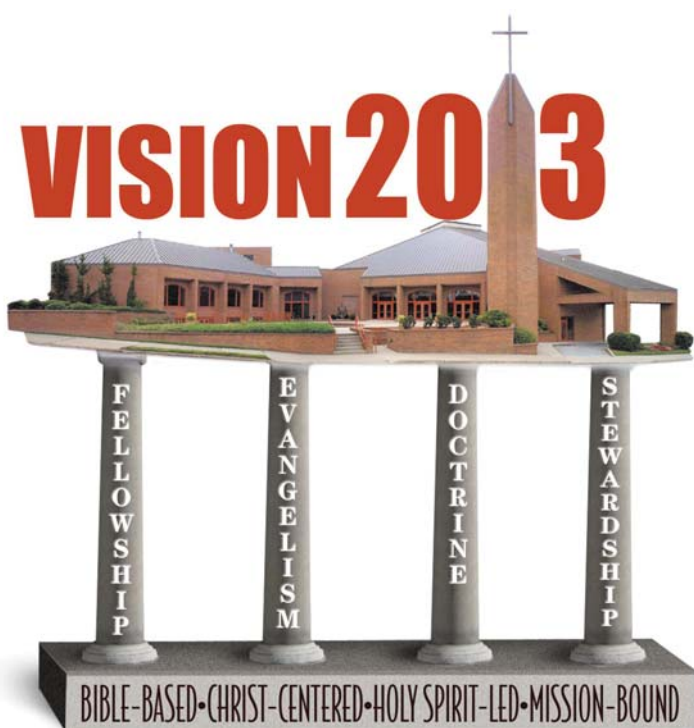

HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY

For the week ending July 20, 2013, 364 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$8,830 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 10,535 pounds of food was distributed, 556 meals served to AUMI residents, and 331 community meals served.
