BOOK SIGNING FOR DAVID VAUGHN

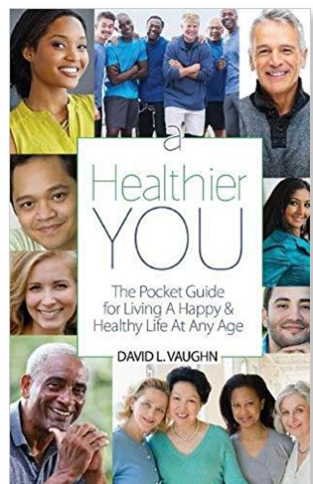

PASTORAL ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

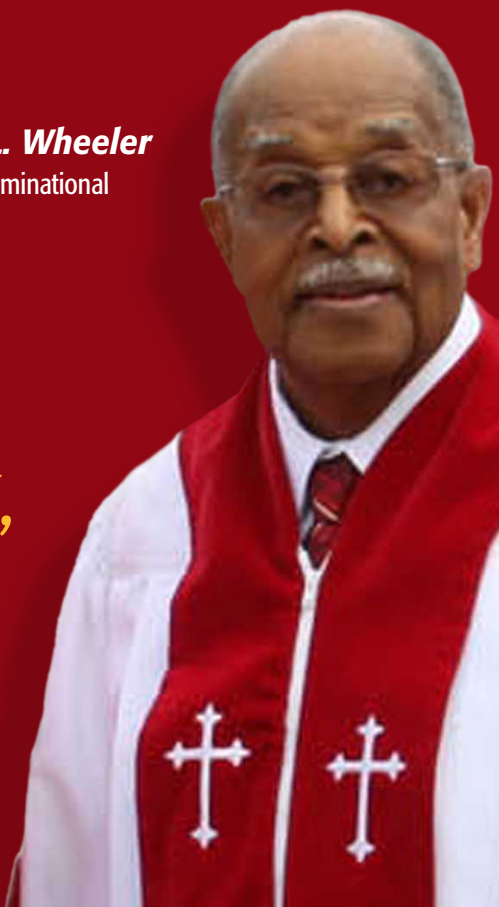
