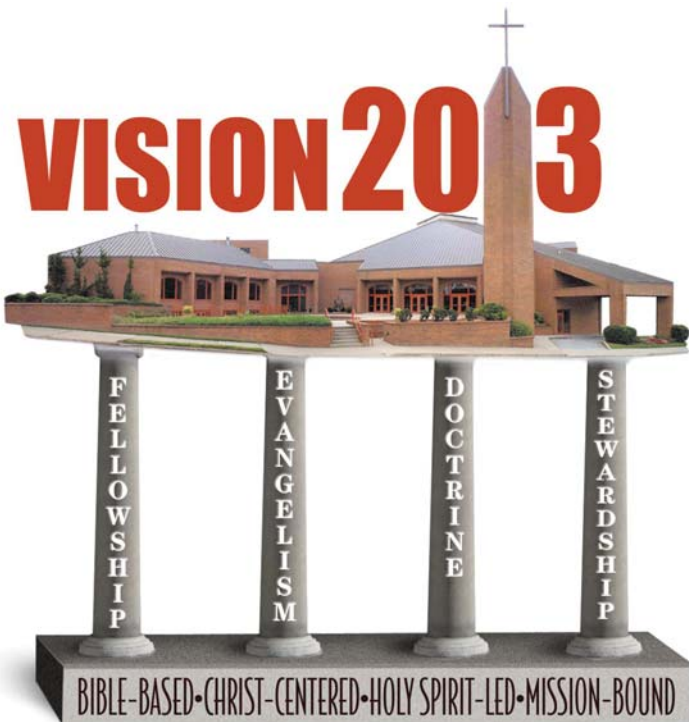

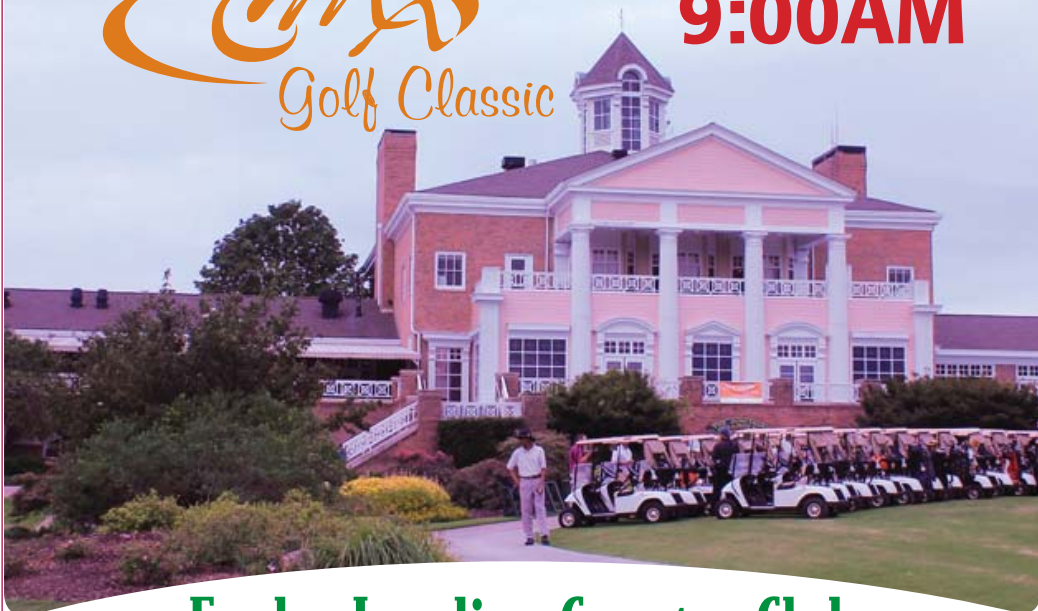

For the week ending August 3, 2013, 348 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$8,420 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 2,643 pounds of food was distributed, 504 meals served to AUMI residents, and 331 community meals served.
