12TH ANNUAL CMA GOLF CLASSIC

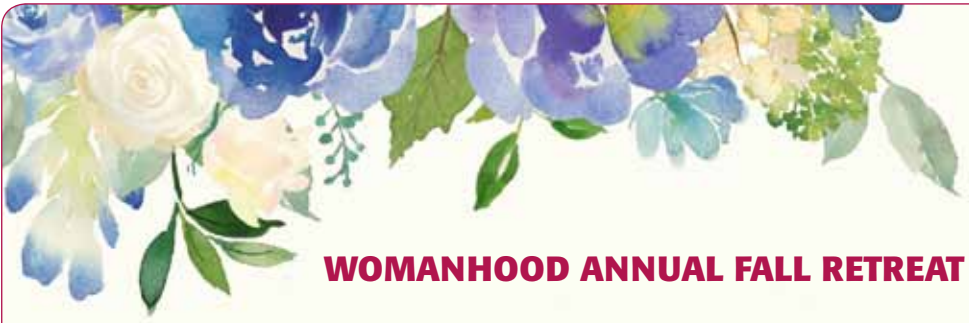
