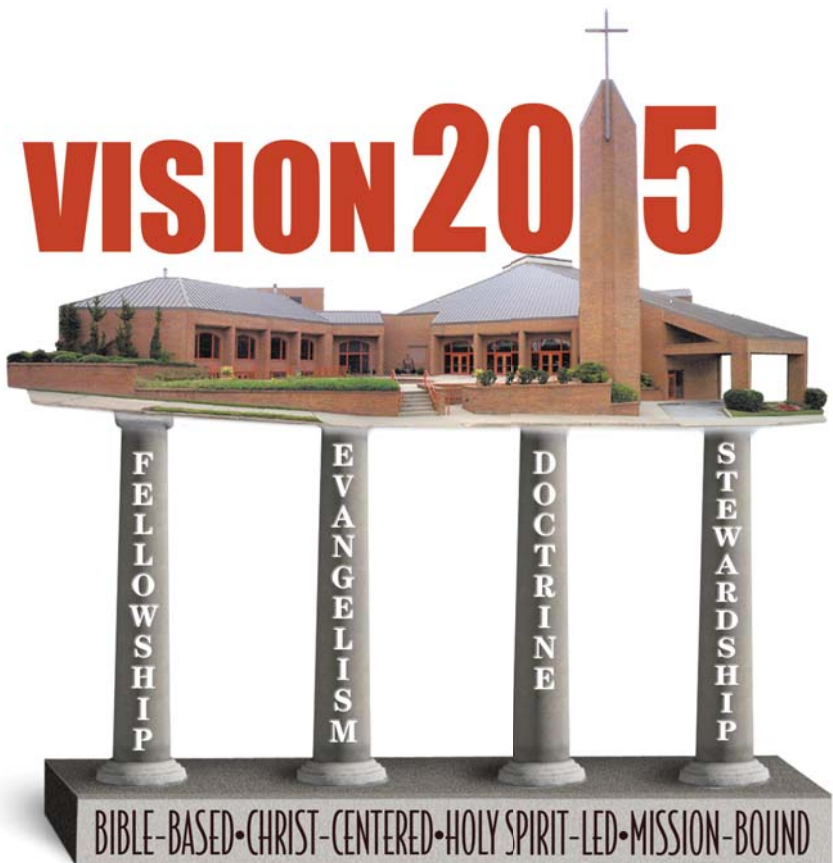

## Remembering September 11, 2001

On September 11, 2001, 19 militants associated with the Islamic extremist group al-Qaeda hijacked four airliners and carried out suicide attacks against targets in the United States. Two of the planes were flown into the towers of the World Trade Center in New York City, a third plane hit the Pentagon just outside Washington, D. C., and the fourth plane crashed in a field in Pennsylvania. Over 3,000 people were killed during the attacks in New York City and Washington, D. C., including over 400 police officers and firefighters. The incident ranks as, by far, the worst case of mass murder in U. S. history, the worst building disaster in human history, and the largest terrorist incident in the history of the western world.

We will never forget and will always pay homage to those lives lost during this horrendous tragedy and will continue to pray for the bereaved families and loved ones left behind. The horror of the collapsing World Trade Center towers, the burning wing of the Pentagon, and the scattered debris of Flight 93 in the Somerset County field will always be a reminder of the destructive nature of sin. Believers, throughout the world, were left shocked, confused, angry, and frightened, their faith tested. But comfort came, not from the secular tributes or memorials to this tragedy, but from the words of the Comforter.

If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14 (extracted from 9/11 sermon Rev. C. M. Alexander)

Therefore, it is through His instructions to us and his words of hope and redemption, that we can remember the victims and pray for their loved ones. It is through His words of love and comfort, that we can remain in constant prayer for the peace of our nation and the world...for God's love transcends all boundaries. Although there will continue to be unyielding reminders of man's inhumanity towards man, as Believers, we can take refuge in His love, an uncompromising, all encompassing love that is found in His Word and in His promises to his children. This, then, becomes the Christian's commemoration to September 11, 2001.
