For the week ending October 1, 2011, 347 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$8,275 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 12,969 pounds of food was distributed, 702 meals served to AUMI residents, and 700 community meals served.
