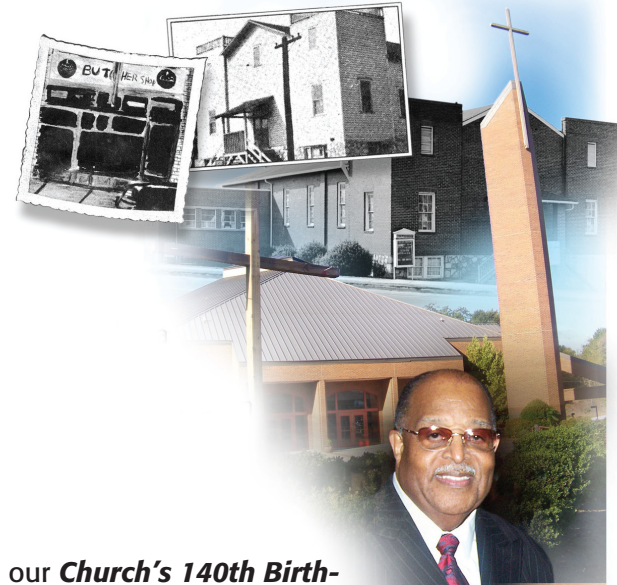
ANTIOCH CHRISTIAN ENTREPRENEURS
