## ANTIOCH SCHOLARSHIP MINISTRY

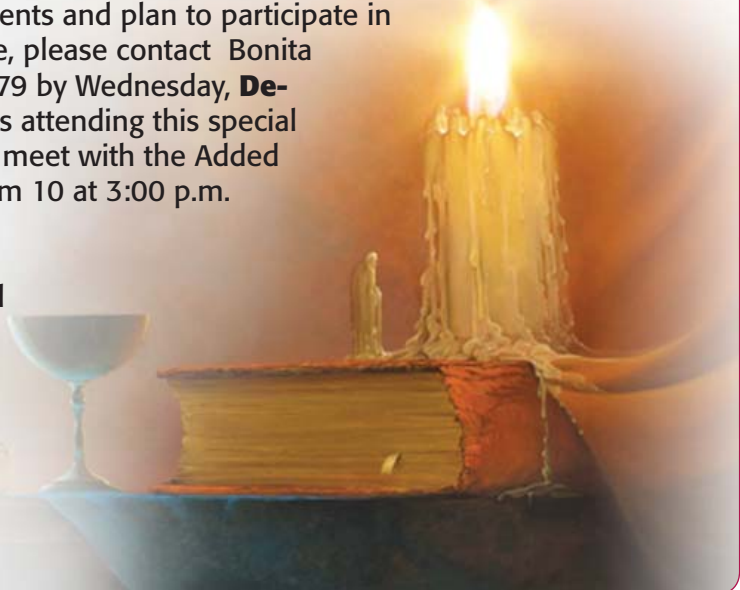
