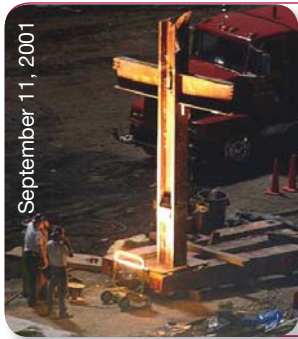

### **HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY**

For the week ending August 28, 2010, 377 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$9,190 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 8,234 pounds of food was distributed, 680 meals served to AUMI residents, and 177 community meals served.
