A Congratulatory Message from the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters,



We are celebrating some momentous occasions experienced by our members from kindergarten through retirement on this Scholarship Ministry Sunday. A young child heading off to school for the first time, filled with excitement, and perhaps some fear, about new adventures, friendships, and opportunities to learn is experiencing a life milestone. The same feelings come on the other end of the spectrum as one retires from a lifelong career—excitement and a little trepidation about what is ahead.

Each of our honorees today has come to a milepost marker on the journey of life. Moving from kindergarten to first grade means no more naps during the school day; it's time to stay actively engaged in the learning process for the entire day. 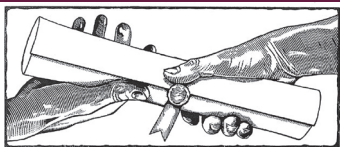
